Molecular Koch's Postulates. In 1988, Stanley Falkow (1934–) proposed a revised form of Koch's postulates known as molecular Koch's postulates. These are listed in the left column of Table 15.4. The premise for molecular Koch's postulates is not in the ability to isolate a particular pathogen but rather to identify a gene that may cause the organism to be pathogenic.
