### My Celebration of Recovery: What is a Step Study?

The four Celebrate Recovery participant guides are a must have if you desire healing from any hurt, habit or hangup. The guides are designed to be used in a Step Study group. The group follows the 5 guidelines (same as the open share groups)so each step study member answers the questions without interruption.

It takes about 9 months to complete the work for a 12 step study. There are separate study groups for men and women. The Celebrate Recovery Bible will be used by the group leader, although you may use any Bible. You need to purchase the following Participant Guides.

### Step Study Assignments Participant's Guide 4

Celebrate Recovery uses the 4 Participant Guides as the curriculum for working through the 12 Steps and 8 Recovery Principals. Our Step Study takes place on a night other than Fridays. The CR Step Study is a personal journey through each of these steps in a confidential group led by a facilitator who has completed the study themselves. When you finish the study you will have worked your hurts, habits, and hang-ups through each step.
