Second Harmonic Standing Wave Pattern . If the frequency at which the teacher vibrates the snakey is increased even more, then the third harmonic wave pattern can be produced within the snakey. The standing wave pattern for the third harmonic has an additional node and antinode between the ends of the snakey.

In simple harmonic motion, the acceleration of the system, and therefore the net force, is proportional to the displacement and acts in the opposite direction of the displacement. A good example of SHM is an object with mass  $m$  attached to a spring on a frictionless surface, as shown in Figure 15.3 .
