The longer the organism has been dead, the larger the difference between the amounts of ^{12}C and ^{14}C there will be. The half-life of carbon-14 is roughly 5700 years, which means that after 5700 years, half of the ^{14}C in a fossil will have decayed into ^{14}N , its decay product. The other half remains as ^{14}C .
