"Pearls" of Neonatal Resuscitation Only 1-2 babies in 1,000 need chest compression and/or drugs Babies who need chest compression and/or drugs are either very acidotic or are not being ventilated appropriately Chest compressions open up the coronary arteries which allow oxygenated blood to the myocardium. IV epinephrine is more effective than ET epinephrine

The previous resuscitation guidelines included five and, later, four rapid assessment questions . The 2011 algorithm asks three questions regarding the status of the infant: "Is the infant of term gestation?", "Is the infant crying or breathing?" and "Is there good muscle tone?".

Neonatal Resuscitation: An Overview Nine out of ten neonates successfully transition from fetus to newborn. Unfortunately, the remaining 10% of neonates require assistance from medical providers. Less than 10% of these newborn babies (approximately 1% overall) will require neonatal resuscitation.

The Neonatal Resuscitation ILCOR and Guidelines Task Forces continue to support use of a 3:1 ratio of compressions to ventilation, with 90 compressions and 30 breaths to achieve approximately 120 events per minute to maximize ventilation at an achievable rate 173-178 (Class IIa, LOE C-LD). Thus, each event will be allotted approximately a half of a second, with exhalation occurring during the first compression after each ventilation.

Neonatal Resuscitation Guidelines: Update 2016

The Resuscitation Council (UK) guidelines have been adapted from the 2015 ERC Guidelines and are tailored specifically to clinical practice in the UK. NICE has accredited the process used by Resuscitation Council (UK) to produce its Guidelines development Process Manual. Accreditation is valid for 5 years from March 2015.

Summary of the Revised Neonatal Resuscitation Guidelines

Although the guidelines for neonatal resuscitation focus on newly born infants, most of the principles are applicable throughout the neonatal period and early infancy. The term "newly born" refers specifically to the infant in the first minutes to hours after birth.
