The Used Car Rule, formally known as the Used Motor Vehicle Trade Regulation Rule, has been in effect since 1985. It requires car dealers to display a window sticker, known as a Buyers Guide, on the used cars they offer for sale.

The FTC has sought public comments on a series of proposed changes to the Rule (formally known as the Used Motor Vehicle Trade Regulation Rule), which requires car dealers to display a window sticker, or "Buyers Guide," on used cars offered for sale. The Guide discloses whether the dealer is offering to sell a used car "as is" (without a warranty), or with a warranty.

The FTC's Used Car Rule says that dealers have to display a Buyers Guide in every used car they have for sale, and give it to buyers after the sale. The FTC recently checked out how dealers are following that rule in 20 cities, visiting 94 dealerships, and inspecting more than 2325 vehicles.

Say Hello to the New Used Car Buyers Guide

The Federal Trade Commission Buyers Guide Rule is part of a Federal Disclosure law that requires all used car dealers to disclose warranty information in writing before the sale of any vehicle. The rule was placed into effect to inform consumers that the written warranty overrides and supersedes any spoken promises made by a motor vehicle dealer at the time of the sale.

In place since 1985, the Used Car Rule requires dealers to display in the window of used vehicles a sticker called a Buyers Guide that contains information about warranties and other specific matters of interest to used car shoppers. A few years back, the FTC put the Rule under the regulatory microscope.

The revised Buyers Guide recommends that consumers get a vehicle history report before buying a used car and sends them to ftc.gov/usedcars for more information on how to get one. The revised Buyers Guide directs consumers that before buying a car, they should visit safercar.gov to check for safety recalls.

Most car dealers who sell used vehicles must comply with the Federal Trade Commission's (FTC's) Used Car Rule. In fact, car dealers who sell, or offer for sale, more than five used vehicles in a 12-month period must comply with the Rule.
